

Hi everyone, welcome to our February 2013 newsletter to keep you up to date on what has happened at Moorvue, we hope you enjoy reading it.

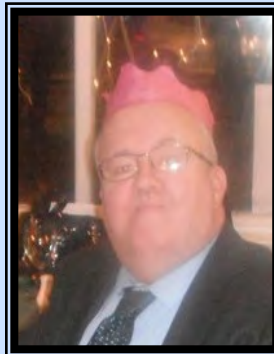
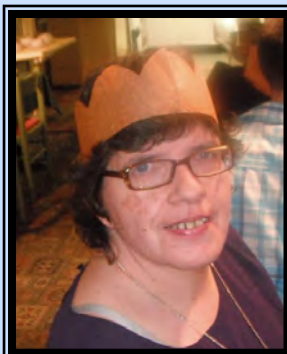
Ceiling Hoist.
